

CBT Specific Terms and conditions

You **MUST** arrive on time for the beginning of the course, you **MUST** be present for the entire course - if you arrive late, after the course has begun, you will not be able to take part and no refund will be given.

You **MUST** have read and understood the current **Highway Code**, as this is a **legal** requirement for all licence holders.

You **MUST** be able to read and understand Basic English language.

You **MUST** present your valid UK photo card licence (or an EU licence supported by a UK driver number) at the beginning of the course. The CBT course cannot legally commence without a valid licence (holders of old style paper licences **MUST** bring their passport as proof of I.D.).

You **MUST** be able to read a standard number plate at a distance of 20 metres. If you need glasses or contact lenses to do this, you must wear them throughout the course whist riding.

You **MUST** inform us of any situation or condition that may affect your safety, or the safety of others, throughout the day.

You **MUST NOT** be impaired by alcohol or drugs.

If using your own bike, it **MUST** be roadworthy; display full size L plates front and rear; have valid tax, insurance and MOT certificate (if bike is over 3 years old). You **MUST** bring all the relevant documents with you.

If the above terms and conditions are not met, you will not be able to complete your CBT and ${
m NO}$ refund or alternative date will be offered
